GETTING STARTED

Creating your The Greek Local account

One free account for everything — your bookings, your credit balance, and the affiliate program. This guide walks you through signing up with email or Google, for travellers and partner businesses alike.

The journey at a glance

Creating an account takes about two minutes. All you need is an email address you can access.

1. **Open thegreeklocal.com** and click **"Sign up"**.
2. **Enter your email and a password** — or simply continue with Google.
3. **Verify your email** with the 6-digit code we send you.
4. **You are in** — your account dashboard opens and a welcome email arrives.
5. **What next:** book your first tour, or apply to the affiliate program and earn.

ONE ACCOUNT FOR EVERYONE

Travellers, hotels, tavernas, and individual partners all start with this same personal account. Business roles — such as joining the affiliate program — are added afterwards from within the account, so there is nothing special to choose during sign-up.

1 Open the site and click "Sign up"

Go to **thegreeklocal.com**. In the top-right corner you will find **"Sign in"** and **"Sign up"** — click **"Sign up"**. The **EN / EL** switch next to them changes the site language at any time.

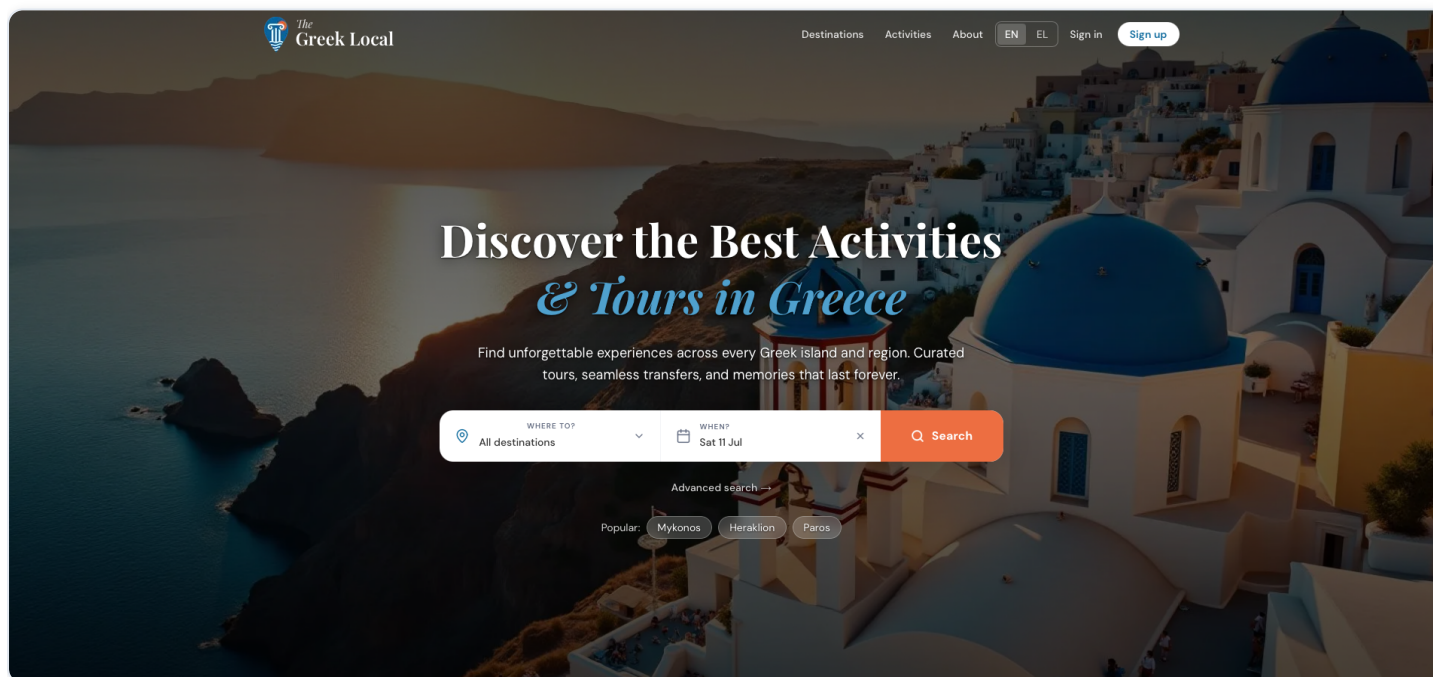


Fig. 1 — The homepage — "Sign up" and the EN / EL language switch are top right.

2 Create your account

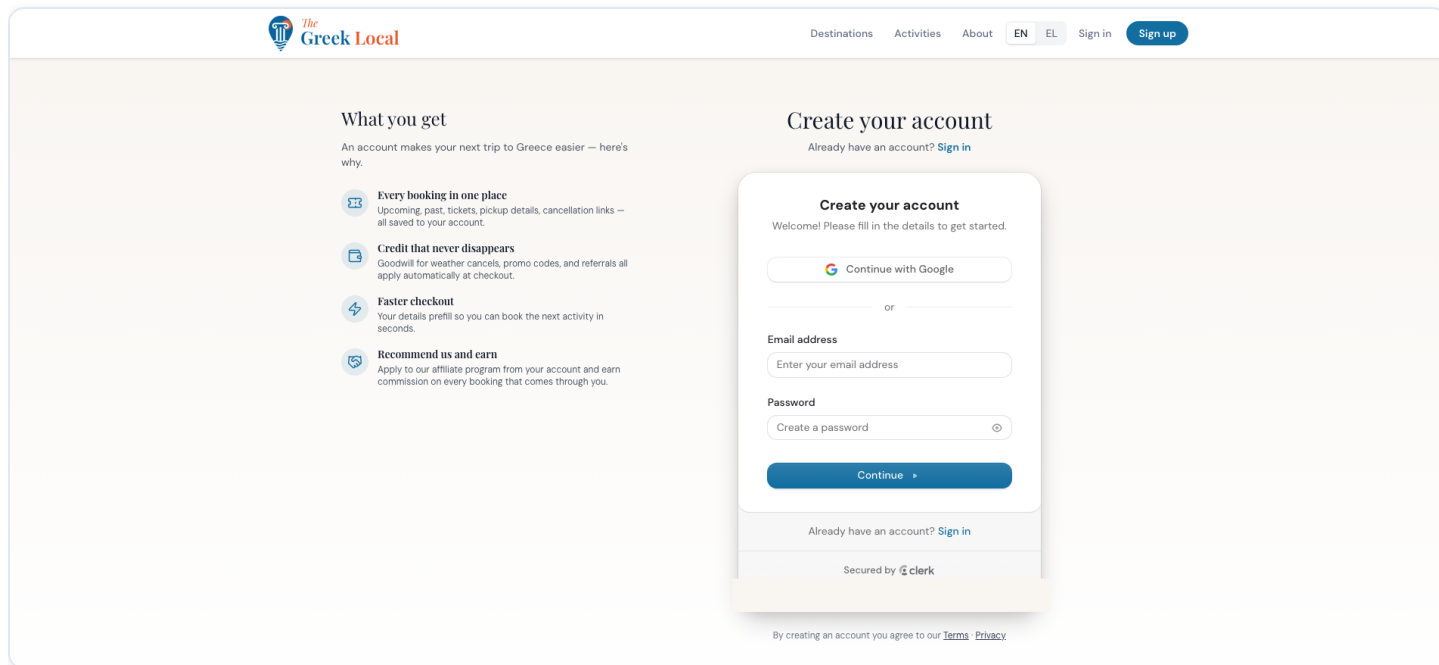
The left side reminds you what an account gives you — every booking in one place, credit that applies automatically, faster checkout, and the option to earn as an affiliate. On the right, fill in the form:

- **Email address** — use an address you can open right now; a verification code is about to arrive there.
- **Password** — the form confirms once your password meets the requirements.
- Click **Continue**.

Alternatively, click **"Continue with Google"** — see step 4. By creating an account you agree to our Terms and Privacy Policy, both linked under the form.

IF A CHECKBOX ASKS YOU TO VERIFY YOU ARE HUMAN

Occasionally a security check appears in the form: **"Verify you are human"**. Tick it, wait a moment, and continue — it is a standard anti-bot check and appears only once.

3 Verify your email

We send a **6-digit verification code** to the address you entered. The email is titled **"Verification code"** and comes from The Greek Local.

- Type the code into the six boxes on the **"Verify your email"** screen — it continues automatically.
- Nothing after a minute? Check your spam folder, or click **"Didn't receive a code? Resend"**.
- Typed the wrong email? Click the small **pencil icon** next to the address to correct it.
- For your security, never share the code with anyone — our team will never ask you for it.

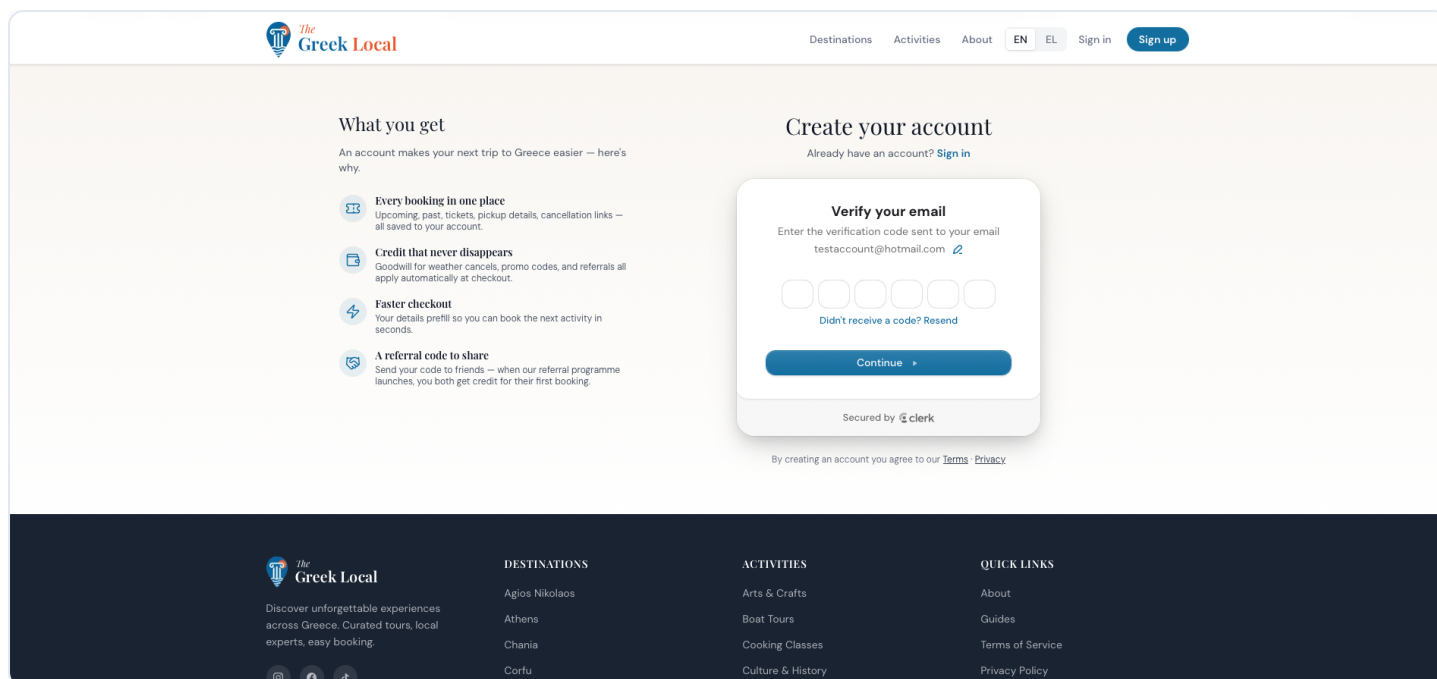


Fig. 3 — The "Verify your email" screen, waiting for the 6-digit code.

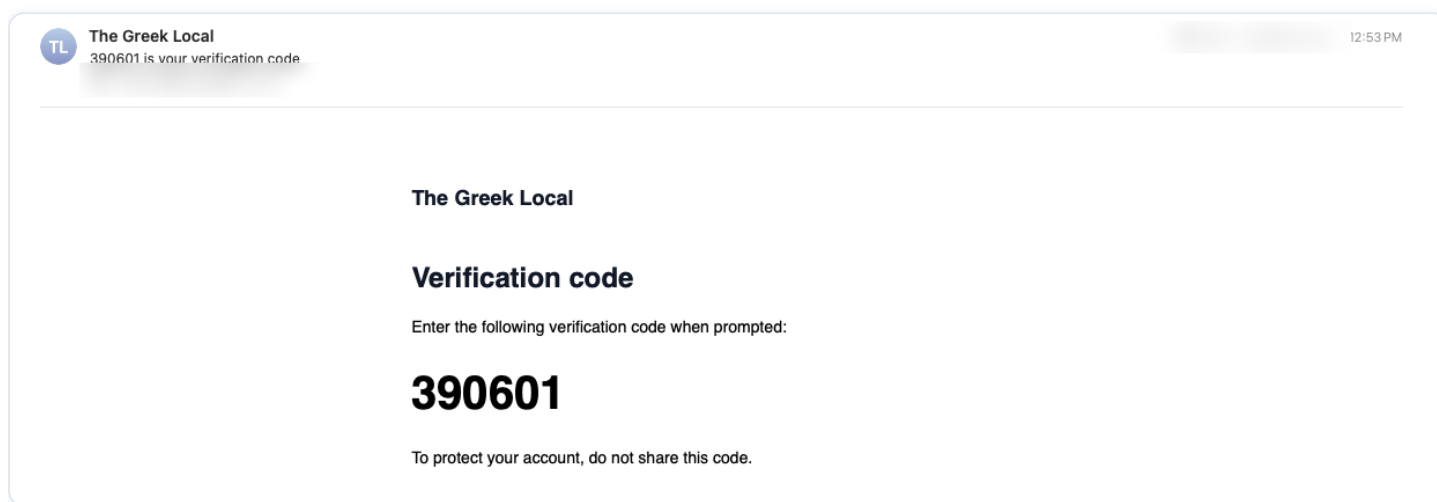


Fig. 4 — The verification code email. This service email is currently sent in English for all accounts.

4 Or continue with Google

Prefer not to manage another password? Click **"Continue with Google"** on the sign-up form. Google asks you to choose an account and confirms what will be shared with us — your name, email address, and profile picture. There is no separate email verification: Google has already verified the address.

Google's screens follow the language of your **Google account**, not the site, so they may appear in a different language than shown here.

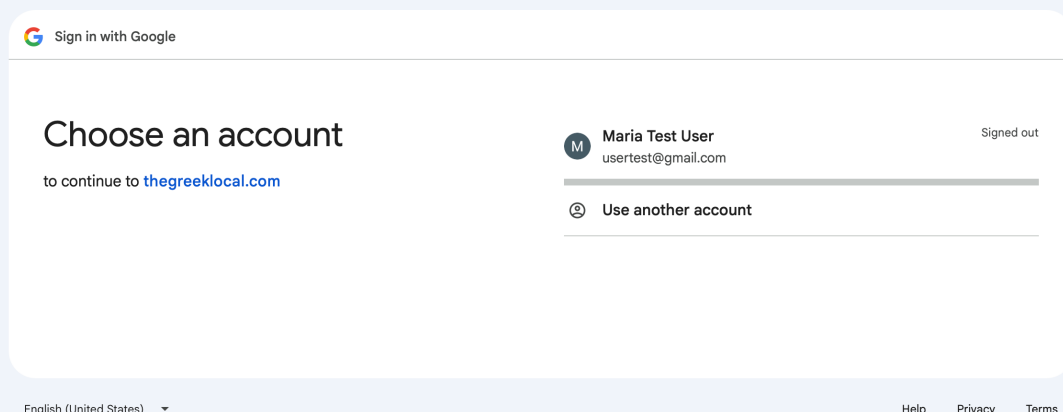


Fig. 5 — Choose the Google account to continue with.

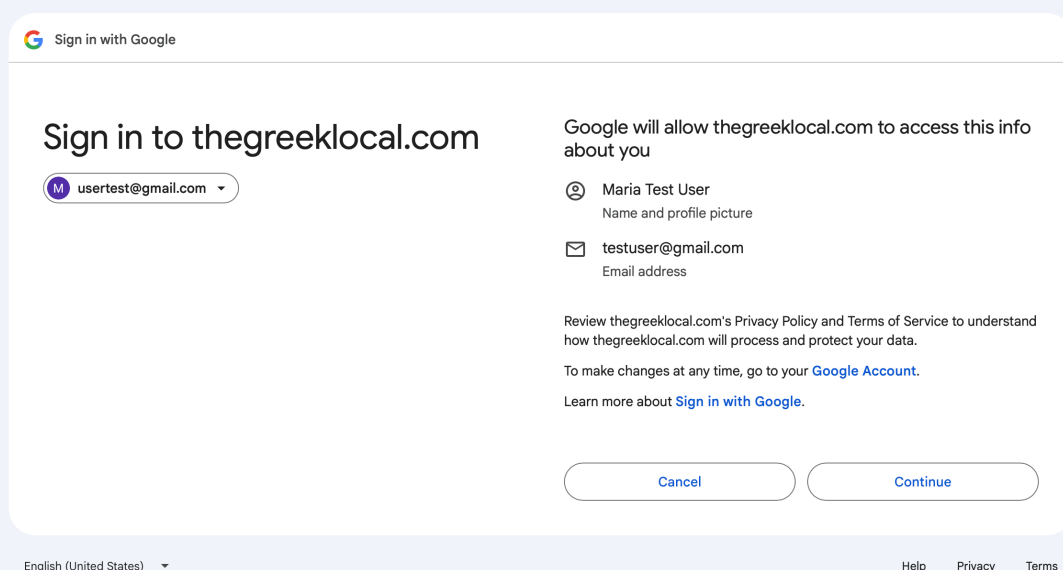


Fig. 6 — Google confirms what thegreeklocal.com will receive, then you are signed in.

5 You are in — your account dashboard

After verification you land in **My account**. The tabs along the top cover everything:

Tab	What lives there
Dashboard	Your overview — upcoming bookings, credit balance, and the referral program card.
My bookings	Every booking with tickets, pickup details, and cancellation links.

Saved searches	Searches you saved while browsing.
Credit balance	Any credit we issue — it applies automatically at checkout.
Profile	Your name, phone, preferred language, and marketing preferences.

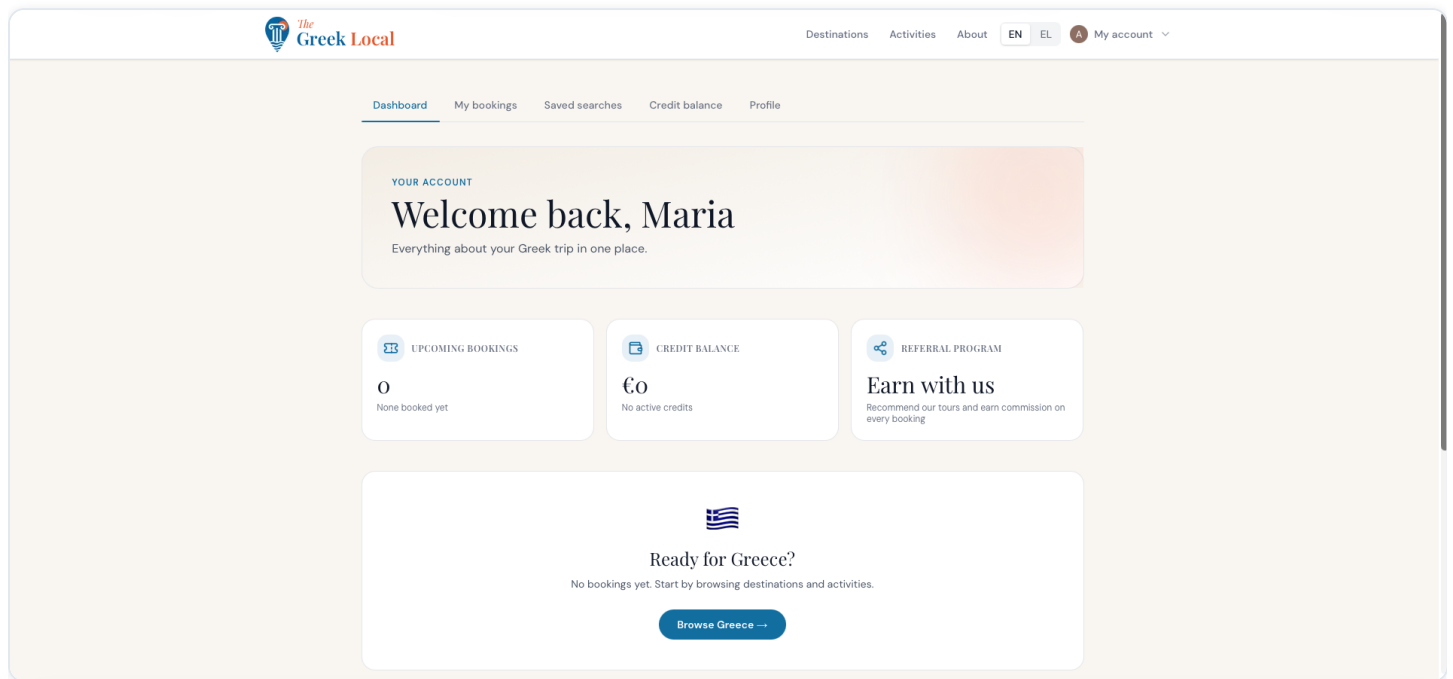


Fig. 7 — Your account dashboard — including the "Earn with us" referral program card.

6 Your welcome email

A few moments after signing up you receive **"Welcome to The Greek Local"** — a short summary of what your account can do, in the language you signed up in.

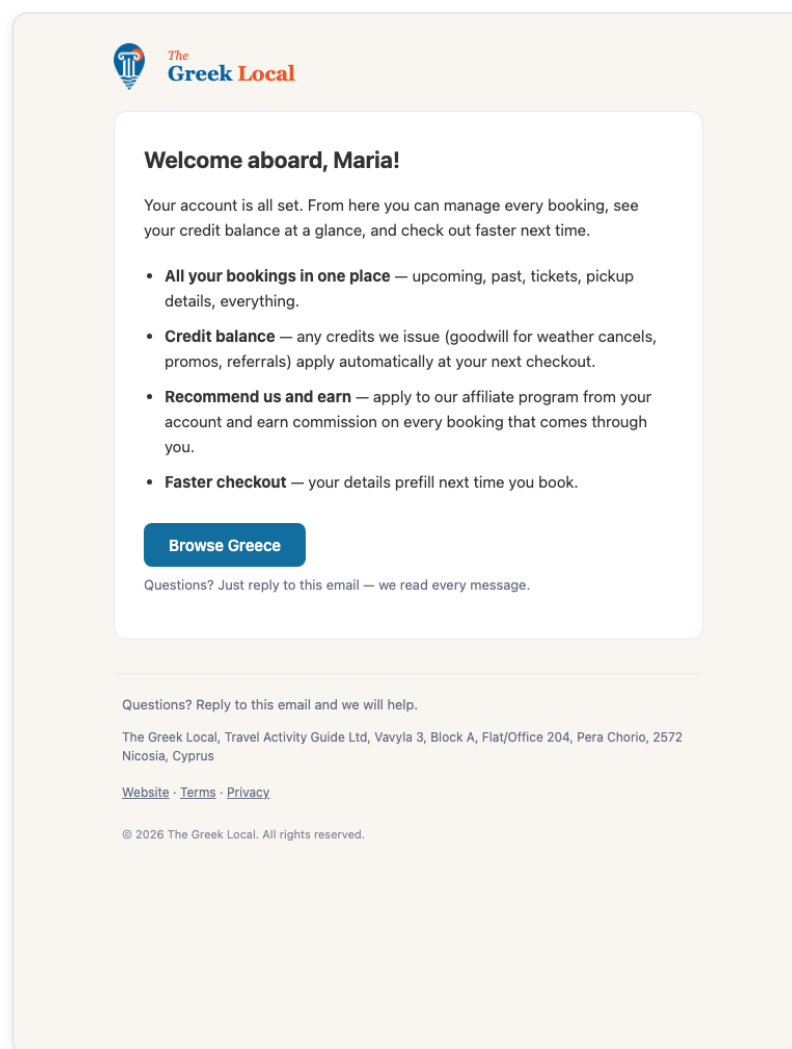


Fig. 8 — The welcome email.

What next

- **Book your first tour** — browse destinations and activities; your details prefill at checkout from now on.

- **Tour operators** — supplier accounts are invitation-based; see "**Getting set up as a supplier**" on the same guides page.

Troubleshooting

Problem	What to do
The verification code never arrived	Check spam, then use "Didn't receive a code? Resend". Corporate mailboxes can delay codes by a few minutes.
I typed the wrong email address	Click the pencil icon next to the address on the verification screen and correct it.
"Already have an account?"	Use Sign in instead — the same page, linked at the top of the form.
I forgot my password	Click Sign in, then "Forgot password?" — a reset link arrives by email.

The site is in the wrong language

Use the EN / EL switch in the header any time; your account also has a preferred language under Profile.
